District. From here there are wonderful views of a beautiful part of God's creation. Today the Honister Slate Mine is still working deep inside Fleetwith Pike producing the world famous Westmorland Green Slate. It has also diversified into tourist activities with various adventure activities and mine tours.

That's where Mining for God comes in, a mine tour with a difference. The beauty of God's creation is all around us there. The miner's life



reminds us of the difficulties which many families face, and we will go from daylight to absolute darkness as we

progress into the tunnels. There are not just tunnels but large caverns with excellent acoustics which lend themselves to a good sing. So we can learn about how slate is mined, how the miners lived in days gone by and something of the geology of Fleetwith Pike. At the same time we can worship God through prayer, readings, and praise, experience the difference that a small light makes to total darkness.





