We're so grateful for all your donations. Food donations have been incredible over the past weeks to the point where our Cockermouth warehouse is completely full and we still have a



huge number of crates stored in the church next door! The last thing that we want to do is to waste food by it going out of date before we can give it out so we've had to close food donation bins during Lockdown 2 to get the stock levels down.

You may of course keep collecting food and then give it to another organisation in the meantime but please **don't** continue to collect food and store it for us to collect when lockdown ends, otherwise we'll be back to square one! Thank you for your continued support and please be assured that we'll be back and will need your food donations again. Thank you.

If you still want to give, and give easily, **Booths** are now running their **Buy**One Give One Free scheme. For every qualifying item that you buy in store, you can pick another one up completely free of charge to donate to your store's food bank collection point.
