Keswick Convention : 15 July-4 August

- The Keswick Convention is here!
The theme this year is **Captivated: hearing God's Word**. In 2017 we celebrate the 500th anniversary of the Reformation, when Martin Luther asserted that his conscience was 'captive' to that Word. At Keswick 2017 we'll see how this powerful Word brings life, reveals Christ and motivates mission. By God's Spirit it will captivate our hearts and minds, and transform our lives, families and churches. All three weeks have at their heart the theme of **Captivated: Hearing God's Word**. In hearing the written word, we meet the living word, Jesus Christ.
- There are lots of interesting seminars, bible studies and events over the three weeks. We've now reached Week 3 where the Bible Reading speaker is Ivor Poobalan taking us through Hebrews. The Keswick Lecture is always popular and this week Mike Reeves shares why the Reformation still matters. Also in Week 3 is Keswick Unconventional, the arts stream, based at St John's. All the information is in the Handbook, available at the Convention Centre for £5. This year we're not hosting The Word in the afternoons, but you can still go to it as it's in a marquee down on the Derwent Site at the old Pencil Factory.
- There's also **Base Camp** on the Rawnsley site where you can find out about mission round the world, visit the bookshop and Tearfund café.
