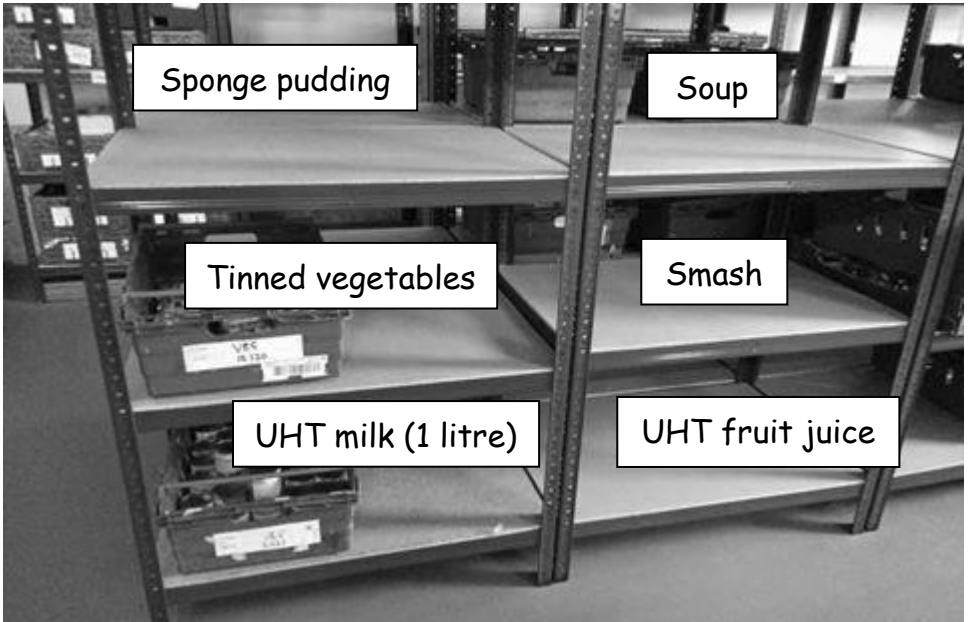

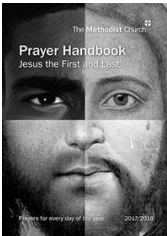
Our shelves are nearly bare! We're now short on most of the items we need to go in our food parcels. In particular we do need the following:
