Emergency News from around the world

- Over the past week, severe flooding in **Nepal, India and Bangladesh** has affected the lives and livelihoods of 17 million people. Christian Aid and other aid organisations are working with their partners in the region to help people whose homes and crops have been lost.
- More than 3,000 people lost their homes in the recent mudslide in **Sierra Leone**, which killed at least 499 people, with more than 600 still missing. There is still an urgent appeal for donations towards relief work through All We Can and Christian Aid.
- All We Can, Christian Aid and other aid organisations are continuing to respond to the threat of famine in **Yemen** (the East Africa Famine Appeal). The situation in Yemen is getting worse. Thousands in Yemen, and in other nations across the region, now face starvation and now cholera. We are urged to continue to do all we can to help.
